

If you are working an ETV plan (attending college), remember that the Kansas FAFSA priority deadline is April 1st EACH YEAR (apply online at fafsa.ed.gov) and your college may have an earlier deadline. You must apply for 3 scholarships each year to continue with ETV. Save your application documentation to send to your IL worker. Please check individual scholarship applications for due dates.
